# A.J. "Bear" Piekarski Scholarship Academic Guidelines

Through the generosity of Brother A.J. "Bear" Piekarski and Laborers' Local 341, a self perpetuating fund will provide a program of yearly scholarships to assist eligible worthy students in furthering their undergraduate education. Scholarships are generally awarded in the month of September for each applicable year.

You may be eligible to receive one of the scholarships awarded through the A.J. "Bear" Piekarski Scholarship program if you meet the eligibility and application requirements set forth below.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- 1. Applicants must be a member or the dependent of a member in good standing with Laborers' Local 341.
- 2. Applicants must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher in their most recently completed semester of high school or post-secondary education.
- 3. Applicants must be scheduled as full-time in the upcoming semester.
- 4. Applicants must complete and submit their application to the office of Laborers' Local 341 no later than August 1 of the requested year.

### **Application Requirements**

- 1. Please print or type clearly with a blue or black pen.
- 2. You must complete the entire scholarship application form. If information is not applicable, please note "NA" in any unanswered section.
- 3. Enclose an *official* copy of your student academic record.
- 4. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation with your application. One (1) letter must be from an educational facility.

#### **Application Procedure**

The exact nature and content of the scholarship program will be determined on an annual basis by Laborers' Local 341's Executive Board. Whereas these scholarships are for the members of Local 341 or their dependents, announcement will be made at <a href="https://www.local341.com">www.local341.com</a> and a letter will be sent to each applicant that a scholarship is awarded to. The announcements will explain the present annual program available and any specifics involved in applying.
